

Road Closure and Diversion Information

Sunday 2 October 2011



The 13.1 mile Coventry Half Marathon, incorporating the Fun Run, takes place on Sunday 2 October. This annual event attracts thousands of runners and raises thousands of pounds for charity. As part of any major event, there will be some disruption to traffic and residents. Please refer to the road closure and diversion information highlighted here.

Road Closures

4.00am – 4.00pm

- Trinity Street – From Hales Street to New Buildings allowing exit from New Buildings.
- Hales Street West – Between Trinity Street and The Burges.

8.00am – 10.00am

- Hales Street East – From Junction 2 of the Ring Road (A4053) to Fairfax Street.

8.30am – 10.30am

- Corporation Street – The carriageway from Hales Street to Fleet Street.
- Fleet Street, Lower Holyhead Road, Watch Close, Moor Place, Spon Street – Total closure for Fun Run and Elite Mile from 8.30am to 10.30am. Controlled exit only from 10.30am to 1.30pm.
- Hill Street – Total closure for Fun Run and Elite Mile from 8.30am to 10.30am. From 10.30am, access from Upper Well Street/Lamb Street/Ryley Street and controlled exit only onto Corporation Street (southbound carriageway only) from 10.30am to 1.30pm.
- Ryley Street – Total closure for Fun Run and Elite Mile from 8.30am to 10.30am. From 10.30am access from Upper Well Street/Lamb Street and controlled exit only via Hill Street onto Corporation Street (southbound carriageway only) from 10.30am to 1.30pm.
- Bond Street – Total closure for Fun Run and Elite Mile. From 10.30am access from Upper Well Street/Lamb Street/Ryley Street and controlled exit only via Hill Street/Corporation Street (southbound carriageway only) from 10.30am to 1.30pm.
- Upper Well Street – From Junction 9 of the Ring Road (A4053) to Corporation Street both carriageways.

8.30am – 1.30pm

- Corporation Street – The carriageway from Fleet Street to Hales Street.

9.00am – 10.30am

- Slip Roads from (A4053) West and East bound at Junction 9 on to traffic island. Road closed in its entirety.

9.00am – 10.45am

- Radford Road (B4098) – Carriageway out of the city from Ring Road Junction 9. Traffic island to mini roundabout at Brownhill Green Road/Sadler Road. Carriageway in to the city from mini roundabout at Brownhill Green Road/Sadler Road to Light Lane.
- Keresley Road (B4098) – Carriageway out of the city from the Mini Roundabout at Brownhill Green Road/Sadler Road to Tamworth Road/The Scotchill roundabout.
- Bennetts Road South – Both carriageways from Bennetts Road to the junction of Watery Lane.
- Bennetts Road – Traffic control on Bennetts Road between Fivefield Road and Watery Lane.
- Keresley Green Road – Both carriageways from Tamworth Road / The Scotchill Roundabout to Bennetts Road South.

9.00am – 11.00am

- Fivefield Road closed in its entirety.
- Tamworth Road – Traffic control on Tamworth Road at the crossroads with Fivefield Road and Hollyfast Lane.

9.00am – 11.30am

- Hollyfast Lane closed in its entirety.
- Wall Hill Road closed in its entirety from the junction of Hollyfast Lane to Wall Hill Farm.

9.00am – 11.45am

- Bridle Brook Lane closed in its entirety.
- Washbrook Lane closed in its entirety.

9.30am – 11.00am

- Tamworth Road – Traffic control on Tamworth Road at the crossroads with Fivefield Road and Hollyfast Lane.

10.00am – 12.15pm

- The Windmill Hill/Browns Lane – Traffic control at Browns Lane/Windmill Hill junction with Washbrook Lane and Butt Lane.
- Butt Lane closed in its entirety.
- Butchers Lane closed in its entirety.

10.00am – 12.30pm

- Birmingham Road – Between Butchers Lane and Rectory Lane to allow access to footbridge.

10.00am – 12.45pm

- Allesley Hall Drive – One carriageway from Allesley Hall to Allesley Old Road.
- Allesley Old Road – Out of city carriageway from Hearsall Lane, Spon End to Allesley Hall Drive. Into city carriageway remains open.
- Spon End – Out of city carriageway from Upper Spon Street to Hearsall Lane.

10.00am – 1.00pm

- Butts Road – Out of city carriageway from Ring Road (A4053) Junction 7 Skydome to Upper Spon Street.

10.15am – 1.30pm

- Ring Road (A4053) Junction 7 Slip Roads – Anti clockwise entry slip road, clockwise exit slip road, lane closure on gyratory.
- Ring Road (A4053) Junction 6 onto Traffic Island – Anti clockwise exit slip road.
- Ring Road (A4053) Junction 6 – Lane closure on gyratory between clockwise entry slip and Warwick Road exit.
- Warwick Road Lane closure from Ring Road (A4053) Junction 6 to junction with Greyfriars Road.
- Greyfriars Road – Lane closure on the northbound carriageway from Warwick Road to Queen Victoria Road. The carriageway in the opposite direction will remain fully open.
- Queen Victoria Road – Lane closure on the northbound carriageway from Greyfriars Road to Corporation Street Croft Road junction. The carriageway in the opposite direction will remain fully open.
- Corporation Street – Lane closure on the northbound carriageway from Queen Victoria Road / Croft Road to Fleet Street. The carriageway in the opposite direction will remain fully open.

10.30am – 1.30pm

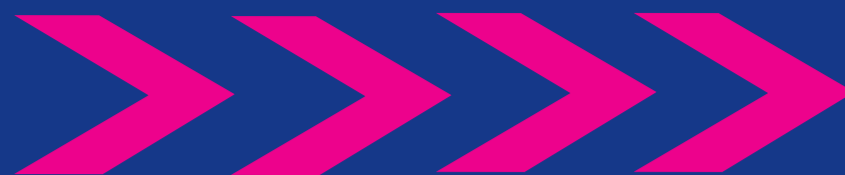
- Upper Well Street – From Junction 9 of the Ring Road Traffic Island to Corporation Street into city carriageway only.

Note: These are estimated times

Diversions

Please refer to the map inside for reference to the city areas and diversions listed below.

- 1 North Allesley, Hawkes End and Brownhill Green**
 - Access to and from North Allesley, Hawkes End and Brownhill Green will be maintained via the Holyhead Road/Pickford Way (A4114) and Coundon Wedge Drive.
- 2 North West of the City**
 - Motorists wishing to head north should divert to the Holyhead Road (A4114), head west along Pickford Way and then north on the Dunchurch Highway (A45)
 - Motorists wishing to cross the Radford Road (B4098), Keresley Road, Keresley Green Road or Bennetts Road South from west to east should divert south to Holyhead Road (A4114), head east to Ring Road Junction 8, travel clockwise to Ring Road Junction 1 and then head north.
- 3 North of the City**
 - Motorists wishing to head north should either:
 - Head east to Phoenix Way (A444) and then head north
 - Head north on Beake Avenue and onto Watery Lane from where there will be controlled access onto Bennetts Road
 - Motorists wishing to head south into the city centre or to cross the Radford Road (B4098), Keresley Road, Keresley Green Road or Bennetts Road South from east to west should either:
 - Travel east along Burnaby Road, then south on Holbrook Lane, Lockhurst Lane and Foleshill Road to Ring Road Junction 1. Then travel to Ring Road Junction 8, head west on the Holyhead Road (A4114), then head north
 - Travel south on Middlemarch Road, Sandy Lane and St. Nicholas Street, then west on Light Lane. Exit left onto the southern section of the Radford Road.



- 4 North of Allesley Old Road, Spon End and Butts Road**
 - Motorists wishing to cross Butts Road (B4101), Spon End, or Allesley Old Road (B4106) from the north should either:
 - Travel west along the Holyhead Road (A4114) and Pickford Way, then head south along the Dunchurch Highway (A45)
 - Travel southeast along Allesley Old Road (B4106), Spon End and Butts Road (B4101) to the Ring Road, then take the Ring Road clockwise to Junction 6
- 5 South of Allesley Old Road, Spon End and Butts Road**
 - Motorists wishing to cross from the south, or travel north west along Butts Road (B4101), Spon End, or Allesley Old Road (B4106) should either:
 - Divert round to the Holyhead Road (A4114), via Earlsdon Avenue, Earlsdon Avenue South, Kenilworth Road, then the Ring Road from Junction 6 to Junction 8
 - Head west on Hearsall Common, Tile Hill Lane and Herald Avenue, then north on the Dunchurch Highway (A45)
